# July Challenge BOTM 2019 "Christmas in July - Christmas Cracker" 



This block is simple, quick and uses up your scraps ( 6 seams in all). It finishes 8 " square ( $8-1 / 2$ " unfinished) using a *scant $1 / 4$ " seam. You can make the entire block in about 10 minutes no kidding! (*to make a scant $1 / 4$ " seam, move your needle one position to the right, so your seam is about a threads-width less than $1 / 4 "$ ").


FABRICS: Chose a dark and a light holiday print with lots of contrast.

## CUT

Cut One (1) square 4-7/8" of each of the DARK and LIGHT fabrics. Cut in half diagonally to create 2 triangles of each fabric.
Cut two (2) DARK and one (1) LIGHT rectangle - each $2-3 / 8 " \times 6-1 / 8 "$.

## SEW

1. Sew the 2 DARK rectangles to each side (lengthwise) of the LIGHT rectangle to form a "rail fence" block (LIGHT block will be in the center). Press toward the DARK fabric.

8" Finished 8-1⁄2 Unfinished
2. Take the 2 DARK triangles and sew on the ends of the rail fence square (see diagram). Trim dog ears and press seams to the DARK fabric.

3. Take the remaining 2 LIGHT triangles and sew on the 2 remaining DARK sides pressing these seams OPEN - as these seams will most likely meet up with additional squares (depending on the layout chosen by the winner of the blocks).
