Summer is busy so lets do a simple but fun block that can make a stunning quilt! Lets see how many you can make. Use a Light, Medium and Dark fabric... Did you know that value is the most important element in your quilt's design? This is a scrapyer the better type of quilt! So mix it up don't make any two blocks the same. Use prints or solids as along as the value is correct for the block you are making. You can make several types of quilt designs with the lay out of this block.






6 ½" Unfinished Block

2 Sew the Dark HST to the Light/ Medium section

as shown. Viola you're done! How many can you make? There are several variations of designs you

can make using this block. It is a favorite!

Please use 100% cotton



For each block cut:

- (1) 3-1/2" square of Light fabric
- (1) 3-7/8" square of Medium fabric cut in half diagonally to give you (2) HSTs Half Square Tringle
- (1) 6-7/8" of Dark fabric cut diagonal to give you one half square triangle.
- 1. Sew the short side of Medium HST to the light 3 1/2" square. Repeat with the other side. Press open.
