Use $100 \%$ cotton fabric and $1 / 4$ " seams
Please prewash your fabric so the colors don't bleed.

## Colors

Any reds print or solid scrappy
gray green
White or white on white

## Cut <br> Red

8 rectangles, $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ 1/2"
4 rectangles, $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ "

## Golden yellow

4 squares $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2 "$

## Gray Green

1 square $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2"

## White

4 squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
12 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Construction

1. On the wrong side of the fabric, draw a line diagonally across each white square. On the right side of the fabric lay a square on each end of each red $21 / 2$ " x $41 / 2$ " and the four red $21 / 2$ " x $61 / 2$ " rectangles and stitch as shown. Trim off corner and press toward the white. Repeat for as shown.

Pay attention to the angle of the white triangles.

2. Sew $41 / 2$ " square to each short unit as shown. Press toward the white. Sew long section to the unit as pictured press toward the red. Make four. Set aside.

3. Draw a line across the wrong side of each golden yellow square. Make four double sided units using a red $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 2$ " rectangle and one white and one yellow $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square as in step one. Pay attention to the color placement and the direction you sew Make four sections.

Yellow on the left White on the right


Press toward red
4. Sew sections together in rows then sew the rows together as pictured.


This would look pretty set on point at each end of a table runner.
