## FABRIC SELECTION

Use "Civil War" or similar reproduction fabrics. Be sure to create contrast by using darks and lights. You can make the background dark and the Xs light, or the background light and the Xs dark. For center square - Quilter's Choice!

## FABRIC REOUIREMENTS

## Background Fabric (see above):

1 square, 11 " x $11 "$ - cut into quarters diagonally to make 4 triangles.


Strips for "X"es (use light if background is dark; use dark if background is light):
1 strip, $2-5 / 8 " \times 42 "$ - cut into 4 rectangles $2-5 / 8 " \times 9 "$.


Small Block Centers
1 square, $2-5 / 8$ " x $2-5 / 8$ "


## CONSTRUCTIONG THE BLOCKS

1. Sew a triangle to each side of two of the $2-5 / 8 " \times 9$ " rectangles. Press seams toward the triangles.
"Soldier's Cot Quilt"


## 13" Unfinished Block

2. Sew the remaining two $2-5 / 8 " \times 9$ " rectangles to each side of the center $2-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Press toward the center.

3. Sew the two units from Step 1 together with the unit from Step 2 as shown. Press these seams OPEN.
4. Place the $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ point of a square ruler in the center of the block. Trim the sides of the block

Rotate the block $180^{\circ}$ and trim to $13 "$ square.
