

## BOTM April 2023: Duck Tracks (generations-quilt-patterns.com)

This block uses 4 fabrics (3 main and 1 background). Tina and I decided it would be fun to use Spring colors. I chose 3 different fabric colors while Tina chose 3 fabrics in the same color family and we both used a low volume background. We can't wait to see your Duck Tracks.

### What you need:

1. 3 main fabrics in Spring colors (you may use different colors or the same color family)
  - a. Fabric A: (2) 4 ¼ inch squares for HST
  - b. Fabric B: (2) 3 ½ inch squares and (1) 4 ¼ inch square for HST
  - c. Fabric C: (2) 3 ½ inch squares and (1) 4 ¼ inch square for HST
  - d. Background Fabric: (4) 3 ½ inch squares and (4) 4 ¼ inch square for HST

### How To Make:

1. To make your HST draw a line down the center of all your 4 ¼ inch background fabrics. Once a line is drawn, lay (2) background fabrics on top of (2) fabric A's, (1) on top of (1) fabric B and (1) on top of (1) fabric C. Sew ¼ on both sides of your drawn line. Once you've sewn your ¼ inch on both sides, cut down the line, iron, and trim to 3 ½ inch square.
2. Once your HST is made you just need to lay your Squares and HST out in order to resemble our two samples above and sew together. You will end up with an unfinished 12 ½ inch Block.
  - a. If you're lucky you may own a HST ruler like Tina which can make trimming these blocks even easier. If you do not have one feel free to message or ask her about this ruler.
  - b. Since you will have 4 HST with your background and fabric A you may choose to just cut a 5 ¾ inch square from each of these fabrics. Sew a ¼ inch all the way around and cut diagonally across both sides, this will give you 4 HST that you need to iron and trim to 3 ½ inches. If you choose to do it this way it is good to starch your fabric since you will be working more on the bias.

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
